Fundraising for Earthquake Victims

Sunday 16 May 2010

There are 42 teams will join this meaningful event.

Before I go into rules of play and competition schedules, I would like all of you to take note of the followings:-

- a) 100% of your donations will go to the Qinghai Earthquake Funding;
- b) Each **Team Skips** please prepare a **cheque** of your team donations payable to Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association (or by cash if you so wish), and **ready to be collected by HKLBA officials at CCC presentation after tournament;**
- c) For **individual donations** from AYFP, FC, HKFC, HKPBC, SBSC, USRC and VLBC, the **Convenors or Team Skips please arrange to have them collected and handed to HKLBA officials at CCC on the same day;**
- d) All players must arrive at the venue by 9:45am on 16 May, 2010 and by 9:56 am, a one minute silence will be conducted before we start our games at 10:00 am. Mr. Tony Chok (CCC), Mr. Mike Worth (HKFC), Mr. Boris Choi (POC), and Ms Winnie Wong at IRC will take charge of the ceremony.
- e) **After the competition, all participants and officials are invited to a reception at CCC** where each of you will receive a souvenir in appreciation of your donations. All costs are borne by HKLBA.

Rules of Play :

- a) Each game will play 10 ends;
- b) No trial ends;
- c) No visits to the heads;
- d) Two points for win and one point for draw;
- e) Final rankings will be decided on points and shot difference;
- f) A burnt end counts as **+2** shots for the opponent team responsible and the end is not replayed;
- g) No score cards will be used. After each game, winner will report result to the Umpire/Venue director on duty.
- h) Although umpires may be assigned to each venue, their sole duties are to order the start and finish of each game, to take results of each game and report to the game controller. As this is a fund raising competition and every team will be playing for rankings but nothing else, I would like to see all matters on the green being dealt with between the two skips;
- i) Team shirts are to be worn during the game; and
- j) Lunch is NOT provided, players to arrange their own.
