TENNIS COURT (REVISED)

Conditions :

1. Opening Hours :
Mondays - Fridays 10:00 - 23:00
Saturdays, Sundays & Public Holidays 9:00 - 23:00
2. Members may reserve the court in advance for one period; at any time, not more than one period per day can be reserved in advance by any one member. Members can book a period of 2 hours during day time from Mondays to Fridays to finish by 5:00 p.m. In the evening peak time, from 5:00 p.m. onwards, all periods are restricted to 1 hour. For Saturdays, Sundays & Public Holidays, not more than a 1 hour period per day may be booked in advance.
3. A period not booked in advance may be used by any member who arrives at the Club and wishes to play (or telephones first to check if a booking has already been made by another member). If another member arrives and also wishes to play, he may take over the court at the beginning of the next 1 hour period if he has not already booked a period in advance on that day.
4. Recognised tennis attire shall be worn, i.e. must be wearing a top, long trousers/skirt or shorts, and white-soled tennis shoes. The Tennis Convenor, Manager or any member of the Committee has the authority to debar from playing anyone who is not properly dressed.
5. Only bottled water is permitted inside the court area. No food, drinks or smoking are allowed on the tennis court. A drinks box is provided for the use of players, and is placed outside the gate of the tennis court.
6. Anyone who does not show & sign up within 10 minutes for their booked session will automatically be charged a HK\$50.00 penalty, and the session will be given to anyone who wishes to play during that time.
7. A member who fails to show up 3 times for a booked session within any six-months period will forfeit the privilege of tennis court advance bookings for a period of 6 months from the date of the third non-appearance. The office will maintain a register of such non-appearances.
